Summary of Outcomes for youth and families receiving Functional Family Therapy Services as part of the Florida Redirection Project. Data compiled by Kim Mason, National FFT Supervisor/Trainer, as part of ongoing quality assurance program.

Highlights of 2011

1. Highest successful completion rate since the inception of the Quality Assurance/Quality Improvement Program. Baseline of 61% successful completion rate in the 2006-2007 fiscal year to 80% successful completion rate in calendar year 2011.
2. 8 of 10 FFT teams meeting QA/QI goal of 75% successful completion rate and 9 of 10 teams meeting Contract Goal of 70% successful completion rate.
3. 7 of 10 teams meeting the QA/QI goal of averaging 3.5 or higher sessions per month per family.
4. Increase of average sessions per month per family from 2.72 in the fiscal year 2007-2008 to 3.55 in calendar year 2011.
5. 10 of 10 teams meeting the QA/QI goal of 8 days or less between referral and open date.
6. Reduction in the time between referral and open from 9 days in fiscal year 2007-2008 to 4.03 days in calendar year 2011.
7. Overall reduction in Incarceration rate from 11% in 2010 to 8% in 2011.
8. All Phase 2 and Phase 3 teams meeting Supervision Goals as set out in 2011 FFT Supervision Manual – averaging 11 ratings or more per therapist each quarter, providing and documenting both individual and group supervision of FFT cases.
9. In 7 of 10 teams therapist received at least 3 Global Therapist Ratings over the course of the year.
10. All teams meeting National Standards related to Dissemination Adherence and Fidelity Scores

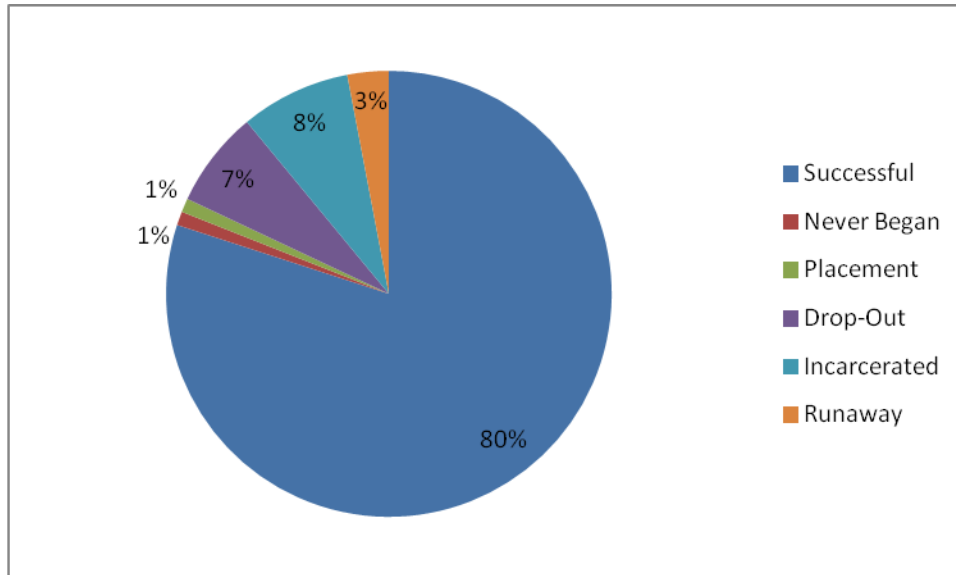

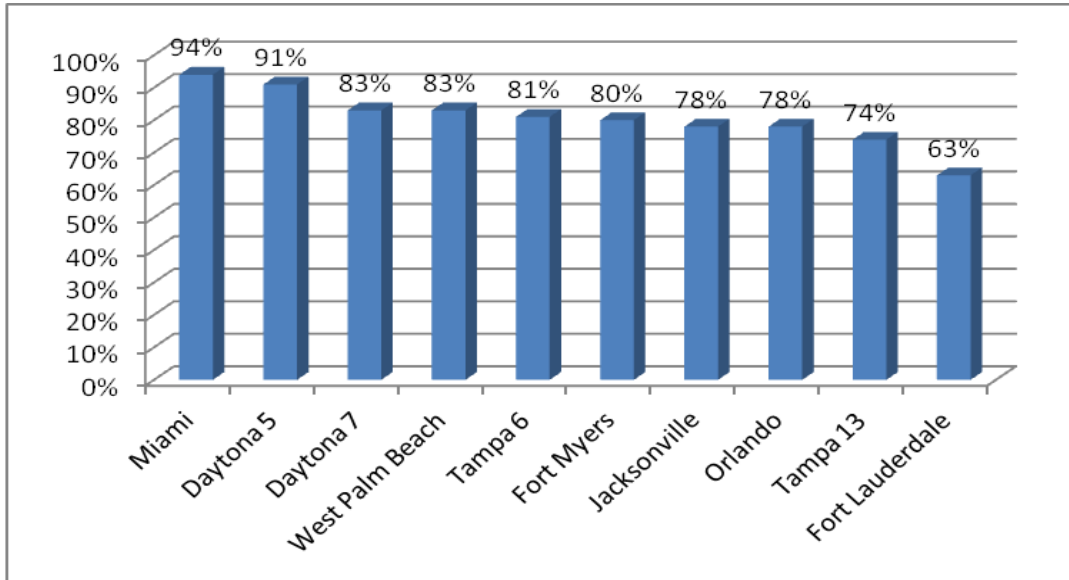

9. Fort Lauderdale

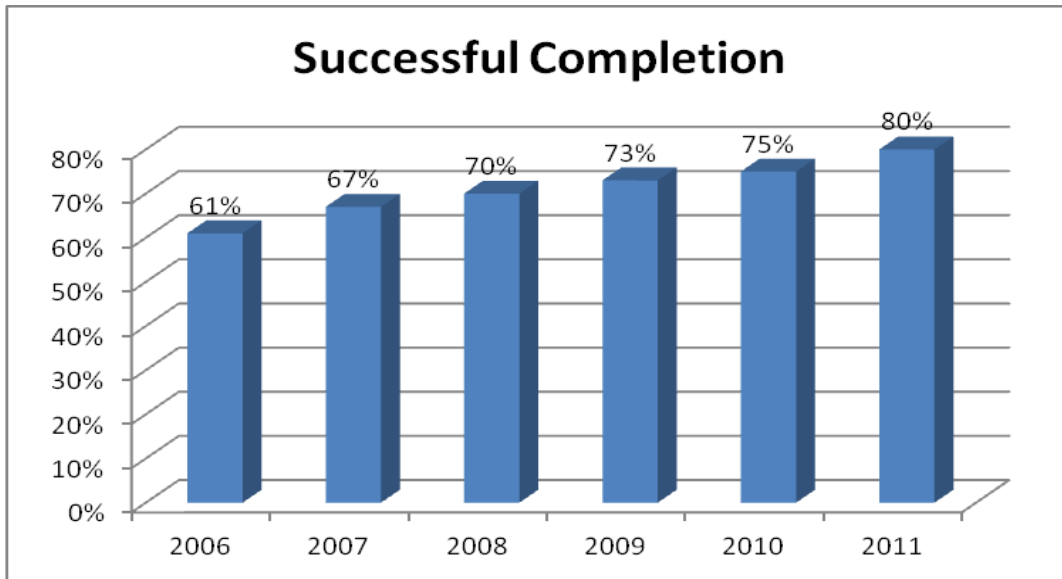
Successful Completion Rates by Categories (January 1, 2011- December 31, 2011) N =996



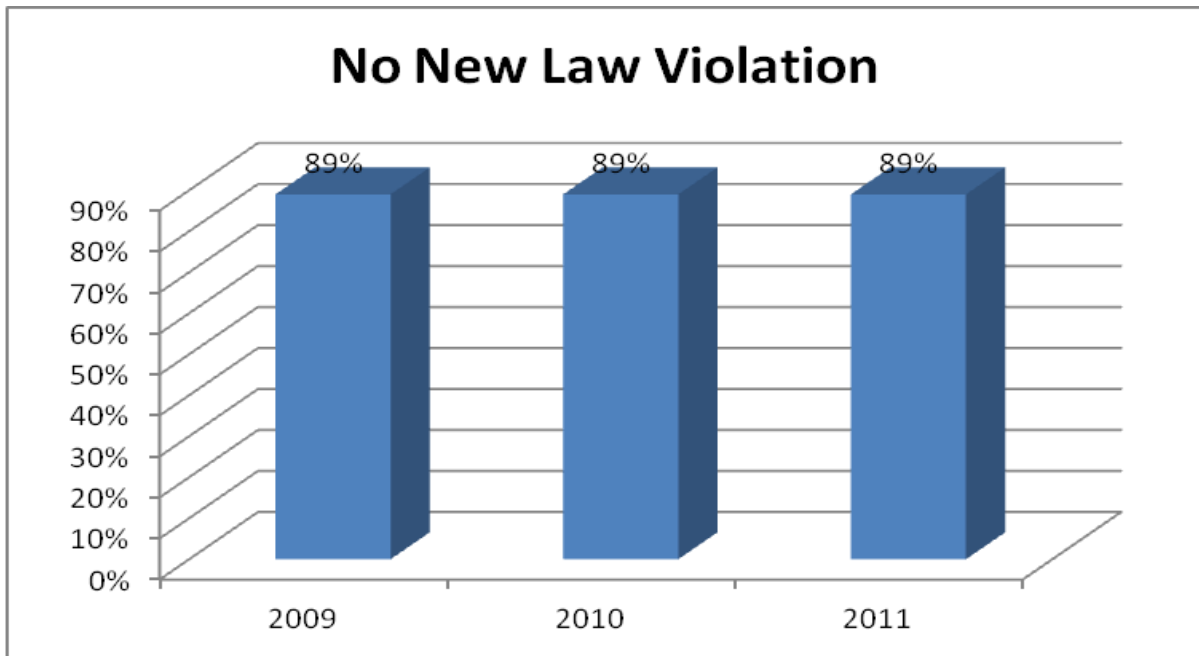
Successful Completion Rates By Team (Contract Goal is 70%, Stretch Goal is 75%)



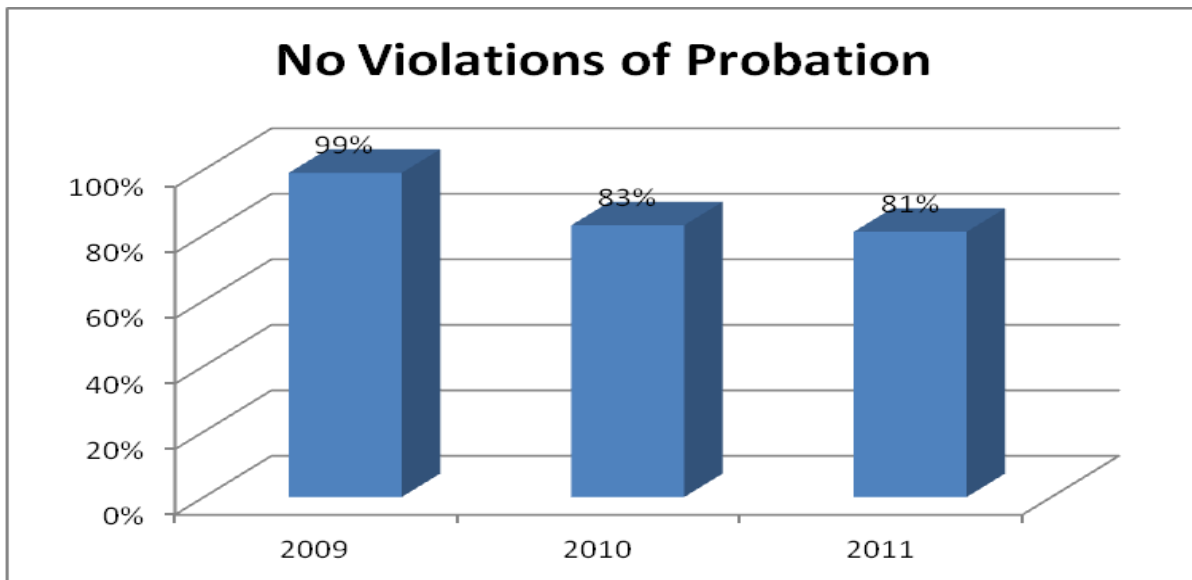
Comparison of Completion Rates over Time



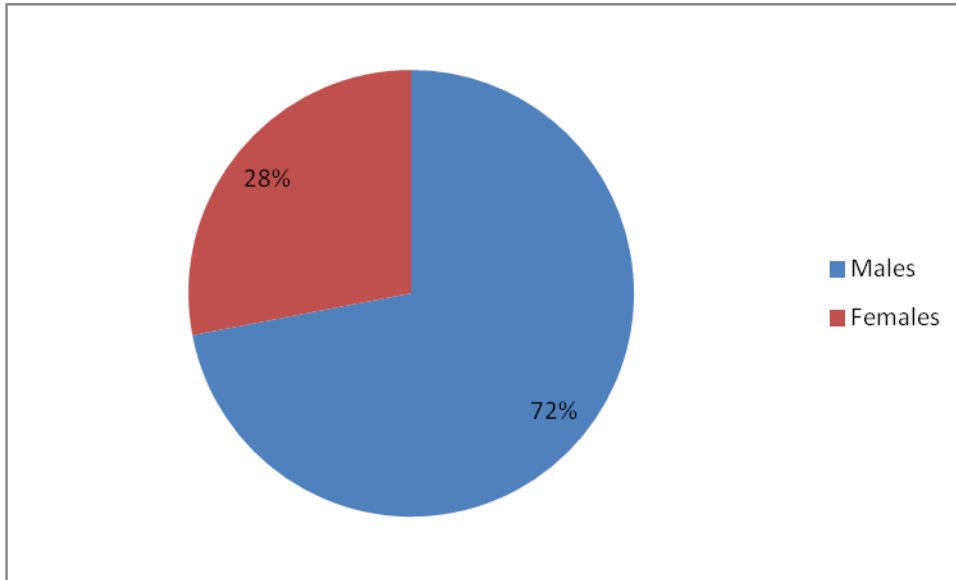

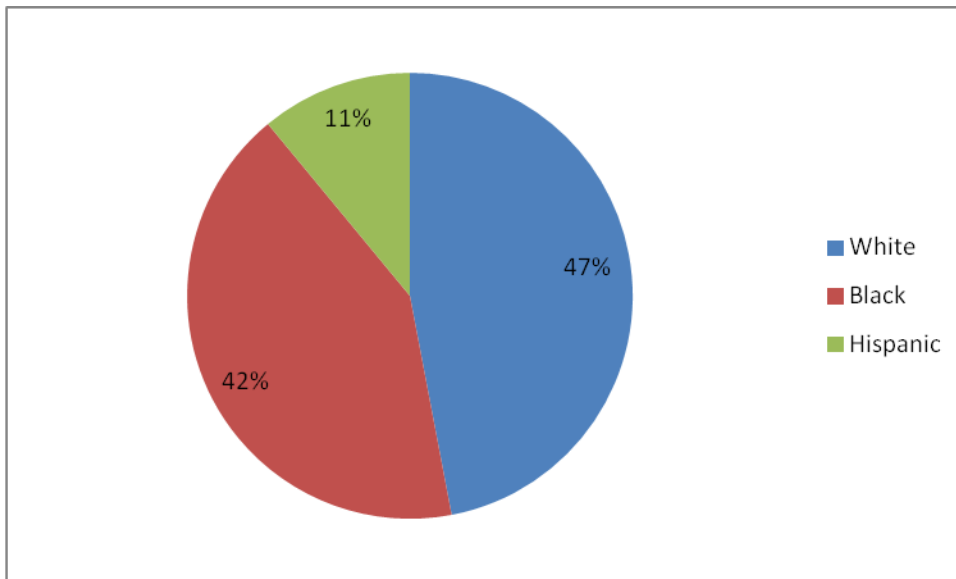

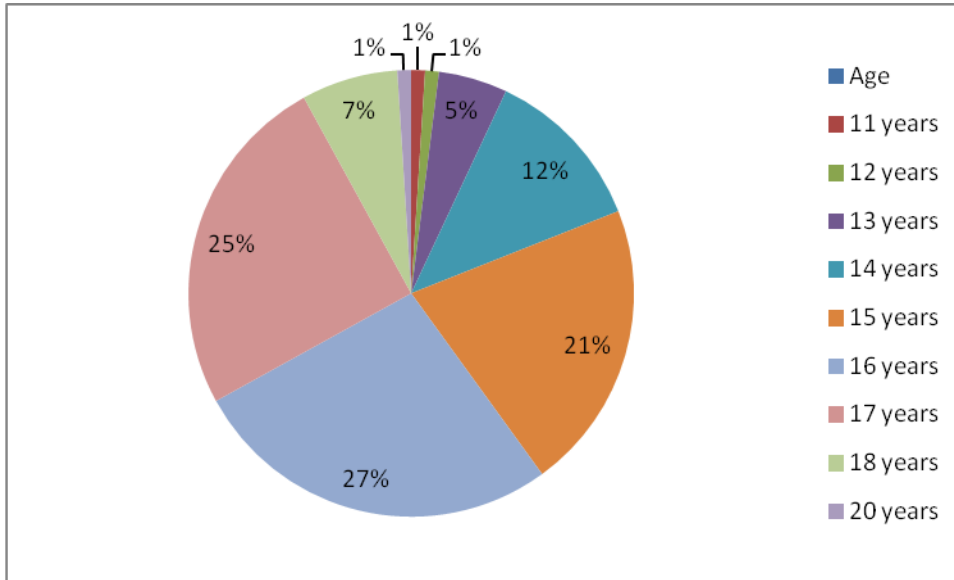
Discharged Cases by Gender (From EBA Discharge Report) N=1054, 759 Males and 295 Females



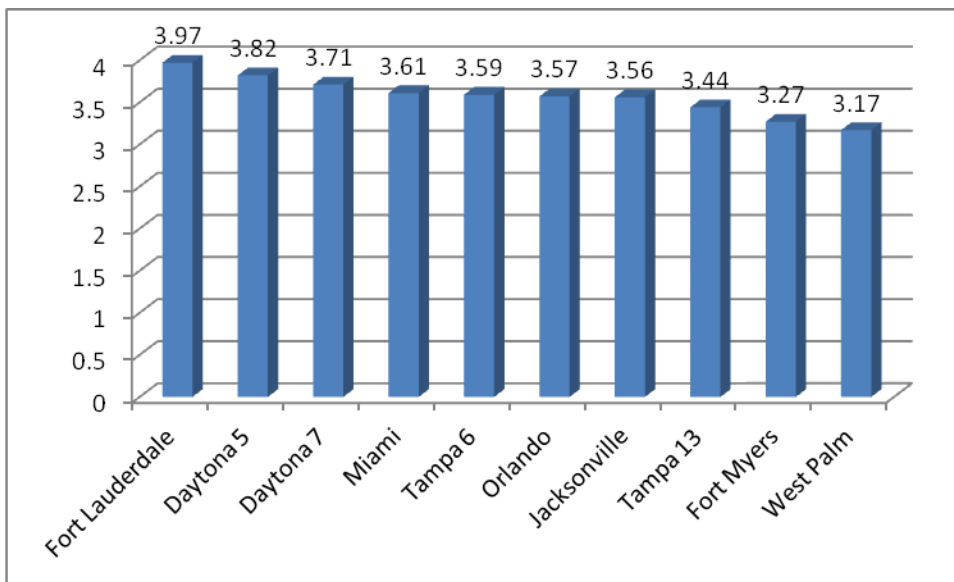
Discharged Cases by Ethnicity (from EBA Discharge Report) N=1054, 495 White, 446 Black and 113 Hispanic



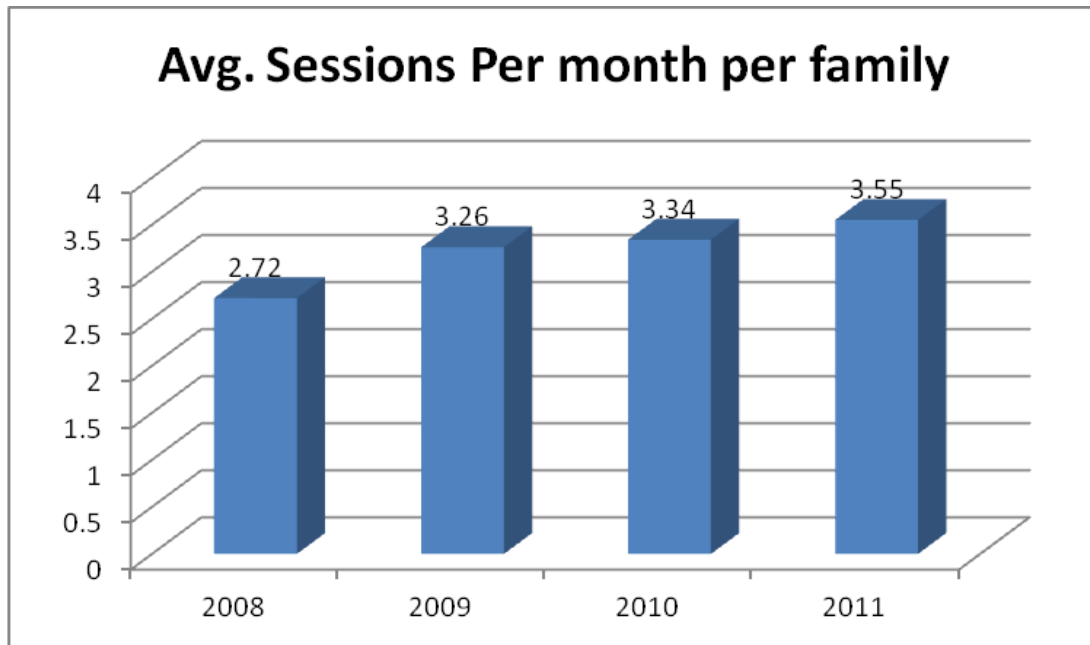
Discharged Cases by Age (From EBA Discharge Report)N=1054



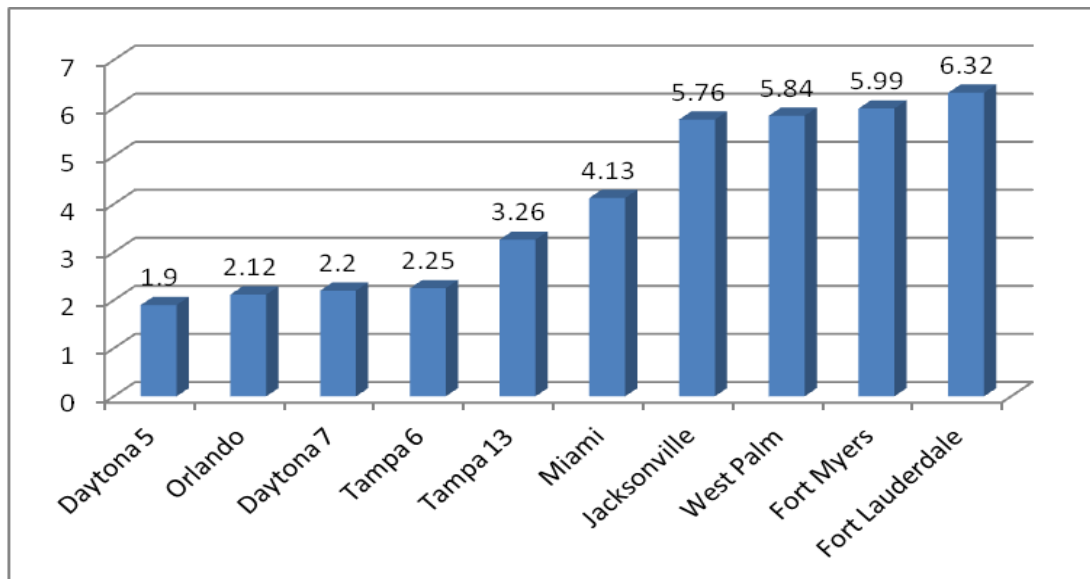
Average Sessions per Family (Goal is 3.5)



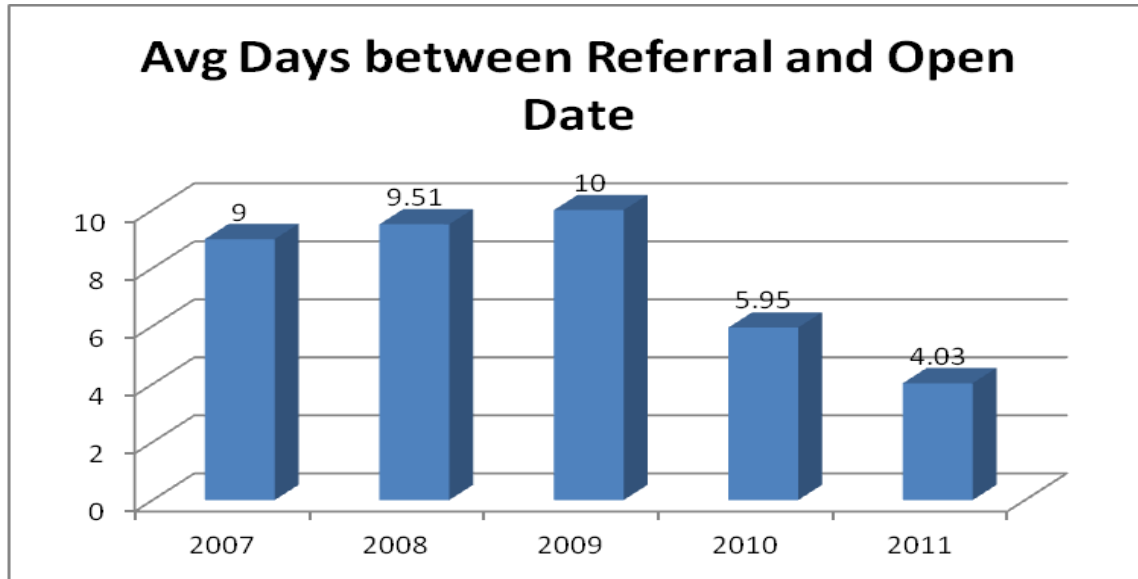
Comparison of Average Sessions over time
